

Energy Saving

As an organisation Atlas Contractors Limited are acutely aware of the limited resources that the world has left to give. By nature of our business we are high users of electricity.

In order to reduce our demands we have a continuous assessment of our needs and monitor our non-essential usage both in the office environment and at our contract sites.

The office environment is monitored and policed by the Managing Directors, who continue to ensure all non-essential electricity use is limited and ultimately reduced to zero. Staffs in the office environment have been instructed to ensure that they switch off their monitors and printers at the end of the day. Staffs have further been instructed to ensure that if they are out of the office they switch off their monitor prior to leaving.

All office key holders are under strict instructions to ensure that all lights, air conditioning units, monitors and printers are switched off before leaving and locking the offices. All non-essential lighting and heating must also be switched off.

Energy saving light bulbs will replace existing bulbs when a replacement is required.

In respect of Head Office there is now only one main entrance and exit, this not only helps with regards to security but also ensures that external doors are not left open thereby allowing heat to escape from the building.

Energy consumption data is gathered on a monthly basis and is reviewed on a regular basis. The statistics arising from this will be presented at our Management Review meetings for discussion and analysis.
